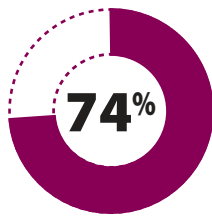

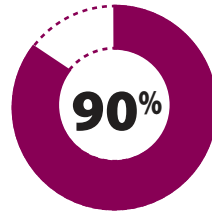
Abused or neglected



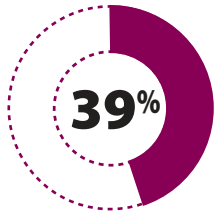
No Biological Parent in Household



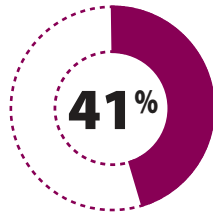
Low Income



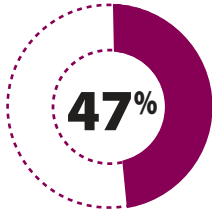

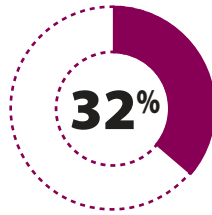
Exposed to Domestic Violence

Experienced Inpatient or Psychiatric Hospitalization

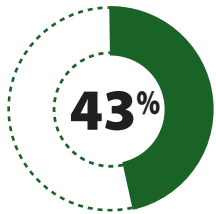

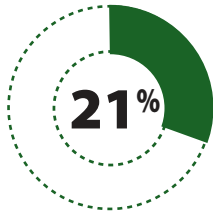

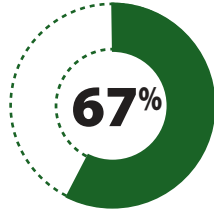
Youth before coming to Mercy Home



Had Attendance Issues

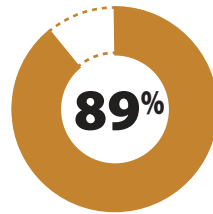


Not on track to Graduate

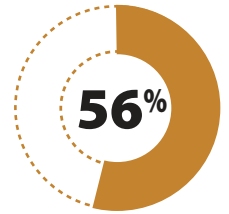
Youth after coming to Mercy Home



Attended school regularly

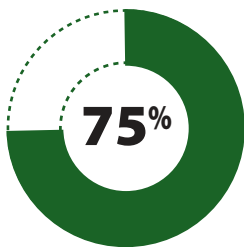

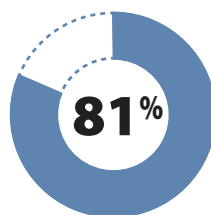

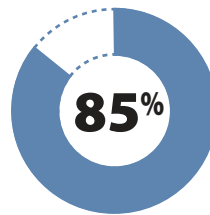

## Long Term Success

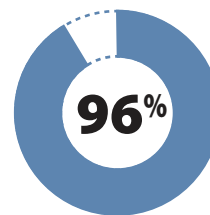
We surveyed former residents to assess the long-term impact of our program on socio-emotional, educational/vocational, and independent living outcomes.



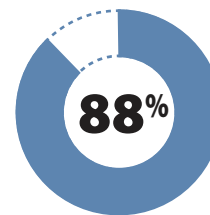
Felt lives improved as a result of time at Mercy Home
